NOTE: Do not submit this application until you carefully read and understand the Conditions of Award for the Flame of Honor.

The Flame of Honor is the highest recognition that the FCF can bestow upon a person. It is awarded by the National FCF Committee. The procedures used in determining recipients shall be:

- 1) Application is submitted to the National FCF Flame of Honor Committee.
- 2) Committee reviews the application and approves or disapproves the request
- 3) If approved, the award is presented by a member of the National FCF Committee.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

The Flame of Honor is the FCF's equivalent of the Medal of Honor (as bestowed by Congress in recognition of extreme heroism), the Nobel Prize (as given by the King of Sweden for outstanding service to mankind), the Medal of Freedom (as issued by the President of the United States) and an honorary doctorate (as given by universities) all combined into one. It is not to be taken lightly. Being recommended is an honor in itself (however the person is never to know he has been recommended) and being chosen demonstrates the FCF's determination to give the recipient the highest honor it is authorized to bestow.

Complete this form to recommend another person to receive the FCF Flame of Honor Award. An application fee of \$100.00 must accompany this application. If the applicant is not approved, the \$100.00 fee will be returned.
